

Regular Meeting
October 15, 2025
7:00 p.m.

CALL TO ORDER: Mayor Pat Showalter called the Council meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. with Council members present, Scott Corsair, Jeff Werth, and Bev Hall. Others present were City Superintendent Richard Hall, City Clerk Debbie Steckline, Ida Meyeres, and Rex Grumbein. Council members Mike Tyrell and Cindy Fuentes-Ummel were absent.

COMMUNICATIONS: Communications were presented and acknowledged.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: Scott Corsair moved to approve the minutes of the RNR Hearing and Regular meeting both held on September 8, 2025, the Budget Hearing held on September 18, 2025 and the Special Meeting held on October 1, 2025 as presented, seconded by Bev Hall. Motion carried unanimously.

OLD BUSINESS: 1. City Clerk, Debbie Steckline asked Council how to handle a Code Violation regarding parking in yard at a residence that has no street parking and no improved parking area. Council recommended that she send a courtesy letter along with a copy of the City Code regarding this violation acknowledging that the Council is aware of the special circumstances and that they are willing to allow the owner time to create an improved parking area.
2. Final paperwork for Requesting a bond from the State for the Street Improvements is signed and will be sent to Robert Perry, Esq.

NEW BUSINESS: 1. Drainage issues at two driveways along Austin Street were discussed and it was determined that a low water crossing at both locations would resolve the issues. Richard Hall will work with T-Roy's Roustabout to do this.
