November 10, 2025

CALL TO ORDER: Mayor Pat Showalter called the Council meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. with Council members present: Scott Corsair, Jeff Werth, Mike Tyrell, Cindy Fuentes-Ummel, and Bev Hall. Others present were City Superintendent Richard Hall, City Clerk Debbie Steckline and Rex Grumbein.
